

# SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This collection, *Civil Rights During the Bush Administration: Subject File of the White House Office of Records Management, 1989–1993*, is divided into several parts: human rights, equality, education, employment, ethnic origin groups, right to housing, voting rights, women, freedoms, civil disturbances, genocide, and ideologies. The majority of this collection is devoted to the subjects of human rights and equality. This collection consists largely of letters to the president and his advisors, drafts of speeches and legislation, and memoranda internal to the White House.

The section on human rights includes documents on Iraq both before and during its occupation of Kuwait. One document describes Saddam Hussein's mass execution of 5,000 political prisoners at Abu-Ghraib prison. Other important human rights topics include human rights in China; women's right to abortion and the Freedom of Choice Act of 1991; human rights in Africa; and anti-Semitism in the Soviet Union. There is also brief discussion of the fatwa issued against Salman Rushdie for his book *Satanic Verses*.

The most significant topics in this collection are the Civil Rights Acts of 1990 and 1991. There is a large amount of correspondence from private individuals, minority organizations such as the Black Leadership Forum, and companies stating their views on these proposed pieces of legislation. There are letters from executives of large companies including Wal-Mart, PepsiCo, K-mart Corporation, Exxon Company USA, the Marriott Corporation, and Halliburton. This correspondence illustrates the views of these individuals and organizations on employment discrimination and racial quotas.

Other important topics in this collection include discrimination against homosexuals in the military, reparations for Japanese Americans interned during World War II, abortion rights and the Freedom of Choice Act of 1991, the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW), and recognition of the genocide of Armenians by Turkey. In addition, there is some coverage of notable events such as the beating of Rodney King and the subsequent riots in Los Angeles, as well as the Tailhook Scandal of 1991.

This collection provides invaluable resources for researchers interested in the evolution of modern civil rights legislation and public response to such legislation. Correspondence from parties on both sides of the political and economic spectrum gives researchers a clear understanding of the pressures on the president of the United States with regard to the signing or vetoing of important legislation.

This collection, *Civil Rights During the Bush Administration: Subject File of the White House Office of Records Management, 1989–1993*, is divided into several parts: human rights, equality, education, employment, ethnic origin groups, right to housing, voting rights, women, freedoms, civil disturbances, genocide, and ideologies. The majority of this collection is devoted to the subjects of human rights and equality.

The section on human rights includes documents on Iraq both before and during its occupation of Kuwait. One document describes Saddam Hussein's mass execution of 5,000 political prisoners at Abu-Ghraib prison. Other important human rights topics include human rights in China; women's right to abortion and the Freedom of Choice Act of 1991; human rights in Africa; and anti-Semitism in the Soviet Union. There is also brief discussion of the fatwa issued against Salman Rushdie for his book *Satanic Verses*.

The most significant topics in this collection are the Civil Rights Acts of 1990 and 1991. There is a large amount of correspondence from private individuals, minority organizations such as the Black Leadership Forum, and companies stating their views on these proposed pieces of legislation. There are letters from executives of large companies including Wal-Mart, PepsiCo, K-mart Corporation, Exxon Company USA, the Marriott Corporation, and Halliburton. This correspondence illustrates the views of these individuals and organizations on employment discrimination and racial quotas.

Other important topics in this collection include discrimination against homosexuals in the military; reparations for Japanese Americans interned during World War II; abortion rights and the Freedom of Choice Act of 1991; the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW); and recognition of the genocide of Armenians by Turkey. In addition, there is some coverage of notable events such as the beating of Rodney King and the subsequent riots in Los Angeles, as well as the Tailhook Scandal of 1991.

This collection provides invaluable resources for researchers interested in the evolution of modern civil rights legislation and public response to such legislation. Correspondence from parties on both sides of the political and economic spectrum gives researchers a clear understanding of the pressures on the president of the United States with regard to the signing or vetoing of important legislation.
