Now, ProQuest is adding full text for premier academic institutions to create ProQuest Dissertations & Theses Global (PQDT Global). Participating institutions include University College London, University of Aberdeen, Cardiff University, University of Leicester, University of Bath, and University of Valencia.


THE WORLD'S MOST COMPREHENSIVE COLLECTION OF DISSERTATIONS AND THESES

PQDT Global brings together content from the world's premier universities—from the Ivy League to the Russell Group. Through planned additions of content from the U.K. and Continental Europe, PQDT Global is projected to grow to more than 2 million full-text works and 3.5 million A&I records by 2015. This rich, multilingual database will add 90,000 full-text works each year, including more than 15,000 works per year from Continental Europe. And, ProQuest is managing all digitization and sharing digital copies of the works with sponsoring universities to make available in their institutional repositories (IRs).

GLOBAL VISIBILITY OF BREAKTHROUGH RESEARCH

PQDT Global is developed by the same team of scholars and technologists that created ProQuest Dissertations & Theses (PQDT), the seminal repository of intellectual property and emerging research from the world's great universities. Originally created in 1939, PQDT now encompasses more than one quarter of a billion pages with nearly 3 million doctoral dissertations and theses. It is the official off-site repository for dissertations and theses for the United States Library of Congress.

More than a thousand new dissertations and theses are added weekly, resulting in more than 90,000 new full-text scholarly works every year. And, the collection is searched over 200 million times a year by researchers from more than 3,000 leading academic institutions worldwide.



GLOBAL DISCOVERY OF CHINESE GRADUATE WORKS

ProQuest joined forces with China Academic Library and Information System (CALIS) to provide first-ever global access to abstracts of the graduate output of 80 Chinese Universities. English-language metadata and abstracts for 150,000 works have been added to PQDT Global, enabling researchers to discover them in the context of works from around the world.
